A speaker and frequent commentator on women's rights, her writing and work have been featured in The New York Times, USA Today, NBC News, Refinery29, Scarymommy, LA Parent Magazine, and many other major media outlets. She has been named the 2020 California Mother of the Year by the American Mothers Organization. After immigrating to the United States when she was 18 years old, Simona graduated from UCLA with a degree in Comparative Literature, summa cum laude.
